Subject:

Reconnaissance

## Overview:

Effective immediately, the following rule changes will go into effect.

- 1. Strike Articles 7.1.C and 7.1.D.
- 2. Replace Article 7.2.A with the following.
  - A. A competitor may use Stage Notes provided specifically for that event by a Rally America authorized vendor to assist in traversing the Special Stages. Stage Notes, when offered, are not required to traverse the stages. A traditional mileage-referenced tulip-style route book (per Article 1.7.F) will always be provided to all competitors irrespective of the availability of Stage Notes.
- 3. Add the following to Article 7.2.C.
  - 1. In events where reconnaissance is available, there is no restriction on the printed or electronic route information used by competitors, other than the restriction on road use described in Article 7.1.B above.
  - 2. In events where reconnaissance is not available, any route information in a competing vehicle and/or used by competitors is limited to what is provided by the event organizer and is subject to the marking allowance described in Article 7.2.E below.
- 4. Strike Article 7.2.D.
- 5. Replace Article 7.3.F with the following.
  - F. All competing drivers and co-drivers are eligible to participate in reconnaissance. Drivers and co-drivers participating in reconnaissance must purchase Stage Notes, except when the driver is not eligible to use Stage Notes.

## Rationale:

These changes are being made to reflect current practice.
