Subject:
Fuel

Overview:

Article 10.1.F requires that competitors “use only street legal unleaded gasoline or diesel fuels that meet *United States* Federal standards”. This rule is unenforceable as written.

Effective immediately Article 10.1.F is replaced with the following:

All Performance Rally vehicles are required to use either:

- A. Unleaded gasoline with a minimum specific gravity of .735 at 60 degrees Fahrenheit and containing no MTBE.
- B. Diesel fuel.
- C. Alternative fuels (e.g. Propane) must be approved by Rally America 90 days in advance of the event.

Rally America will be testing for lead, MTBE and specific gravity at National events as well as selected Regional events.

Article 10.1.F.1 refers to “Member teams of the... Manufacturer’s Council”. Rally America has no such council, rendering this rule irrelevant.

Stewards may interpret this bulletin as necessary to resolve penalties or protests.
