Subject: Marking Stage Notes

Overview: Article 7.2.E specifies markings which are allowed on stage notes. The purpose of this bulletin is to clarify certain markings which are allowed.

Effective immediately, the allowed markings are not only limited to teams which are “unfamiliar with this course following language”.

Effective immediately, terms such as “Brake”, “Caution”, or similar may be added to alert drivers to changes in the character of the stage (e.g. after a long fast stretch leading to a tight corner).

Effective immediately, Article 7.2.E.3 refers to all information included in the route book, the official notice board, supplemental regulations or event bulletins.

Effective immediately, distances may be converted from yards to meters or mileage (tenths or hundredths), but must be converted consistently throughout the notes.

Stewards may interpret this bulletin as necessary to resolve penalties or protests.
